#### Spaldwick acorn branches out!

An oak tree grown out of a fallen acorn from the grounds of Spaldwick Primary School has been planted within the parkland of the National Trust's Belton House, near Grantham in Lincolnshire.

8-year-old Dylan collected the acorn in 2019 and has nurtured it ever since. Having outgrown numerous pots in the garden, time came for a permanent home to be found.

After making the necessary arrangements, Dylan delivered his oak tree to the rangers at Belton in August 2022, who placed it in quarantine in their tree nursery.

On Saturday 14th January 2023, ranger Sacha arranged a very special tree planting attended by Dylan, parents Heidi & Chris and Dylan's grandparents.

The tree, which replaces a recently deceased oak, is positioned near the historical Lion Gates, next to two oak trees each estimated to be over 150 years-old, and is protected by rabbit and deer proof fencing.

Belton House was built in the late-1600s by Sir John Brownlow. The stately home is surrounded by formal gardens and a series of avenues, leading to follies within a larger wood park. It was handed to the National Trust in 1984.

#### Spaldwick Neighbourhood Watch - by coordinator David Henrick

The UK government's new Emergency Alerts system will be live early this year, and you should receive a test message. The system will enable people to be contacted via their mobile phone when lives are in danger.

It will be used to warn you in the event of emergencies, such as severe flooding. Emergency Alerts are sent to all compatible mobile phones within an area of risk. They don't track your location, need your phone number, or collect personal data. Only the government and the emergency services will be able to send them. If you don't have a mobile phone, you'll still be kept informed through other channels.

If you get an Emergency Alert on your phone, you'll hear a loud, siren-like sound.

A message on your screen will tell you about the emergency and how best to respond. You'll be able to check an alert is genuine at gov.uk/alerts. If you receive an alert, read the alert carefully and follow the instructions. You can opt out of receiving emergency alerts; for more information on how to opt out please go to gov.uk/alerts. To find out more about Emergency Alerts, visit gov.uk/alerts.



#### Reporting a crime:

If you are unlucky and have been a victim of crime you can report it in several ways:

- If it's an emergency and the crime is still taking place, call 999 and ask for the police.
- If it's not an emergency, do not call 999. This doesn't mean the crime is not important it just helps the police to make the best use of their resources. Many police forces use the 101 non-emergency number, so you can ring that number instead.
- If you have information regarding a crime and don't want to talk to the police, contact Crimestoppers online or call 0800 555 111. You will remain 100% anonymous. Always.


