

# Spaldwick Neighbourhood Watch - by David Henrick

Almost 21 million reports have been made to the Suspicious Email Reporting Service (SERS), resulting in the removal of over 235.000 malicious websites.

SERS was launched by the National Cyber Security Centre (NCSC) and the City of London Police in April 2020 to enable the public to forward suspicious emails to an automated system that scans them for



Mobile phone providers also offer a service that allows customers to report suspicious text messages, by forwarding them to the number 7726. The service is free of charge and enables providers to take down malicious websites and block malicious texts from being sent across their network. As of May 2023, 54,000 text message scams have been removed as a result of suspicious texts forwarded to the 7726 service.

**How to protect yourself from scam emails and texts:** If you receive an email or text that seems suspicious - report it.

- Forward suspicious emails to report@phishing.gov.uk send emails to this address that feel suspicious, even if you're not certain they're a scam - authorities can check.
- Forward suspicious text messages to 7726 (it's free of charge). Your provider can find out where the text came from and block or ban the sender.
- If you've lost money or provided personal information as a result of a phishing scam, notify your bank immediately and report it to Action Fraud at actionfraud.police.uk
