# Spaldwick Allotments - by Adrian Lemmon



Not everyone has access to an allotment, but there are lots of things that can be grown in the back garden and now is the time to start.

With the weather warming up, now is a great time to plant seed potatoes. Put some multipurpose compost at the bottom of a large pot, add 3 seed potatoes and cover them up with soil. It's that easy!

Tomato and cucumber plants can be put into grow bags as soon as the risk of frost has disappeared - stake them so they have something to support them.

Lettuce can be grown in troughs and strawberries can be grown in hanging baskets. Herbs can be easily grown in pots and add a beautiful aroma to your garden.

### The TING Bus

TING operates in partnership with the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Combined Authority to provide demand responsive journeys in West Huntingdonshire centred around the town of St Neots and Huntingdon. The TING bus will collect you from any address within the service area. A bus stop is not required.

Journeys must be pre-booked but this can be done on the day of travel. Bookings are made by ringing 0115 777 3187 or by downloading the Vectare DRT app.

Buses operate every Monday-Saturday except bank holiday Mondays. First pick-ups are available from 6am each day with last drop-offs by 8pm.

The adult fare is £2 each way, £1 for riders under 19, and children under 5 travel free when travelling with an adult. Also, dogs can travel for £1 all day when accompanied by a well behaved human! Concessionary passes are accepted on the service between 09:30 and 20:00 Monday-Friday and at all times on Saturdays.

The TING bus will be visiting the village on Friday 2nd June - the exact time is yet to be confirmed check social media or village noticeboards closer to the date.
