Launch of new, on-demand bus service serving Spaldwick



Ting is a new on-demand bus service, aimed at supporting rural communities across the western part of Huntingdonshire (pictured right).

The new 'Uber' style bus service isn't fixed to a specific route or timetable. It provides passengers the option to book an on-demand, tailor made service in real time by using the ting trips app. It runs between 7am-7pm (Monday-Friday) and 8am-4pm (Saturday).

The 6-month trial has been put forward by the Combined Authority as a public transport option to get people out of their cars, to help the region meet the 2050 Net Zero target for carbon emissions.

Dr Nik Johnson, Mayor of Cambridgeshire and Peterborough, said: "Using the car is often the only option for residents in many of our rural communities. They simply don't have the same access to the public transport services which are available to their counter parts in our market towns and cities".

The scheme is urging people to "stop, hang up and call 159" to check calls are for real.

The idea is to help those who believe they have been contacted by scammers claiming to be their bank, or by fraudsters who encourage them to transfer money.

According to Stop Scams UK, criminal gangs stole over £470 million from individuals and small businesses last year by pretending to be a bank or other service provider, encouraging consumers to falsely make a payment or transfer money.
