Door step crime Police advice is not to buy or sell anything at your door. It is generally safer never to allow someone into your home unless you have a pre-arranged appointment.

Distraction burglary Common methods include pretending to be from the gas, electric or water companies, asking to use your phone, asking for water or directions. None of the utility suppliers will ask to come inside without calling ahead, meter readers may need to access your home if your meters are indoors and will have ID.

Rogue Traders Most rogue trader behaviour is illegal and punishable by law. Many rogue traders are able to get away with what they do because they target elderly and vulnerable people who lack a support system and less able to defend their own interests.

Pedlars - It is illegal to sell door to door without a pedlars licence.
