"NW volunteers more important than ever" says Home Office Minister Police-recorded crime has risen by 10% across England and Wales the largest annual rise for ten years - according to the very latest Office for National Statistics figures.

Police recorded 458,021 more offences compared with the previous year, which the ONS said was driven by an increase in violence - police recorded an 18% rise in violent crime, including a 20% surge in gun and knife crime

Jayne Pascoe, Strategic Partnerships Director for Neighbourhood Watch, said: "We have also seen a rise in burglary and robbery but we do need to be mindful that these recent increases should be seen in the context of substantial falls in such crimes over the last 20 years. "However it's timely to remind supporters of the importance of staying vigilant and looking out for each other and being aware of what's happening in our neighbourhoods - and shows that Neighbourhood Watch is needed now just as much as ever."
