The number appeared on their phones as a withheld number; please either ignore it, or answer it, but do not give out any personal details.

This company is not affiliated to either the Police and or NHW.

#### FRAUD ADVICE

At this present time there are numerous schemes by fraudsters to obtain money and personal details from the public - these generally are mailed, faxed or sent by email, they originate from a number of countries. They are sent by professional fraudsters who make a living from this and at all times may seem plausible - but don't get hooked - ask yourself...'IS THIS TOO GOOD TO BE TRUE?'- if it is - then it is more than likely a scam.

Lotteries You may be contacted by email/phone/letter. You will be informed that: You have won a considerable amount of money on a lottery.

If you reply, you will be asked to send money to claim your win. Don't reply!

You will lose money if you get involved.
