The Neighbourhood Alert system is an <u>online</u>, <u>secure</u> community messaging system that allows authorised administrators to log in and send messages to registered people in the community, members of Neighbourhood Watch and other schemes who have chosen to receive them. Messages can be sent by email, telephone or text message by a range of approved Information Providers such as the Police, Neighbourhood Watch administrators, Trading Standards and the Fire Service.

At present ONLY six people in our Village are registered! All I need is your email address.
