A14 Roadmarkings Scheme

On behalf of the Highways Agency I am writing to inform you of road marking works starting shortly on the A14, between junction 21 (Brampton) and 13 (Thrapston) eastbound and westbound. This is a continuation of the scheme that took place last year.

The works are programmed to commence on the evening of Monday 6 June 2011 and are expected to take approximately 2 weeks to complete. The works will be carried out in two phases. The first phase will involve a westbound carriageway closure from Monday 6 June to Friday 10 June. The second phase will involve an eastbound carriageway closure from Monday 13 June to Friday 17 June.

The working hours are:

8:00pm to 6:00am Monday to Friday nights

During the road closures there will be fully signed diversion routes. The diversion route will be

Traffic wishing to travel during the westbound closure on the A14 will be diverted north on the A1 to leave A1(M) at J17 to take the A605 and then rejoin A14 at J13 (Thrapston). Traffic wishing to travel during the eastbound closure will use the same diversion route but in reverse.

There will inevitably be some noise generated by the works and any noisy operations that need to be undertaken will be completed as early as possible each evening. We apologise for any inconvenience these works may cause.
