Community Defibrillator for Spaldwick - Shayne Parfrey, Spaldwick Parish Council

Through the generosity of the Woolley Hill Wind Farm Community Fund, part of the Cambridgeshire Community Foundation, Spaldwick Parish Council has secured funding for a Public Accessible Automated External Defibrillator (AED).

We have received support from the CambridgeShire Community Foundation



An AED is a compact, portable device which can be used on an individual, adult or child where it has been recognised that they have had a sudden cardiac arrest or heart attack. The AED is designed specifically for untrained members of the public to use, and as the first eight minutes of heart failure are the most vital, the use of a defibrillator on a patient during this time, increases survival

Thanks to Spaldwick Electrical, the AED has now been fitted to the Community Room, next to Spaldwick Community Primary School and is now registered with the Ambulance Service. So when appropriate the 999-call is made, the call handler will direct any caller to the location and provide the access code to unlock the cabinet and then provide instructions on how to use the device on the patient.

David O'Brian is our local East of England Ambulance Trust Community First Responder (CFR), and we are very grateful to him for his kind assistance, not only the acquisition, but the ongoing maintenance of our AED.

David will also be providing Defibrillator and CPR Awareness Training at the Spaldwick Community Room on Saturday, 18th September at 11am.

The training will cover three key areas and take about an hour, with time for questions: (1) Community First Responding and what it means for the Community; (2) Using the AED; (3) Basic CPR


