




Spaldwick fell silent as mark of respect to the fallen at 11am on November 11th, Remembrance Day.

A special service was held on the Village Green, with poppy wreaths and small wooden crosses placed in front of the War Memorial.

At 12.30pm, the bells of St James Church were rung as part of the national 'Ringers Remember' event, part of commemorations marking 100 years since the end of the First World War (pictured right).



A few years ago Spaldwick Parish Council were asked if allotments could be provided for local residents of Spaldwick and the surrounding area.

The Small Holdings and Allotments Act 1908 imposed a duty on councils - which remains in force - to provide allotments if six or more people say that they want them; but the cost of laying water pipes was considered prohibitive. (It was suggested the cost should be borne by those few initial allotment holders). The Parish Council made tentative enquiries earlier this year and a lot more than six residents stated they still wanted an allotment. Anglia Water were then asked to conduct a survey and responded positively saying they could connect to a single standpipe in the field on Stow Road.

By Parish Councillors undertaking some of the work themselves and the use of Community Infrastructure Levy monies, the cost has been kept to a minimum and will not be passed on to allotment holders. There is still work to do before any allotments are ready and The Parish Council would like to hear from anyone who is interested in offering assistance, expertise or time to set up an Allotment Association.




